
- 93 families viewed the online presentation.

84 viewers used the links provided to learn more about the information shared


40 participants completed the Spring PAC Meeting evaluation


I learned the results of the 2023 Title I Spring Survey and was given the chance to voice my questions and/or suggestions via email to the PIC. 40 responses




I was informed of the School-wide Improvement Plan. 40 responses
